Greetings from Holston Camp and Retreat Center,

Summer camp is a special time for your child. At Holston Camp we create and celebrate special moments that give meaning to your child's stay. Children remember life-changing events that occur at camp. They remember the songs, the games, and the smell of the campfire. They remember making new friends. - The last two weeks of camp will be based out of the Rustic Village Campsites.
